

French A1 Level Syllabus

The A1 level is designed for absolute beginners and focuses on the basics of the French language. At the end of this course, students will be able to understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at satisfying concrete needs.

1. Listening Comprehension

- Understand basic phrases and common expressions related to personal and family information
- Follow simple conversations about everyday topics (weather, food, hobbies)
- Recognize basic questions and instructions in slow and clear speech

2. Reading Comprehension

- Read and understand short, simple texts such as advertisements, menus, and schedules
- Extract key information from simple forms and public notices
- Understand basic personal letters or messages

3. Speaking (Interaction and Production)

- Introduce yourself and others, ask and answer questions about personal details
- Participate in simple conversations if the other person speaks slowly and clearly
- Describe your surroundings, family, hobbies, and routines using simple sentences

4. Writing

- Fill out basic forms and write simple notes and messages
- Compose short texts about personal topics (introductions, daily activities, likes/dislikes)

5. Grammar & Vocabulary

- Articles (definite/indefinite), nouns and adjectives (gender and number)
- Basic sentence structure: subject + verb + object
- Present tense of regular and common irregular verbs (être, avoir, aller, faire)
- Personal pronouns, possessive adjectives
- Common prepositions, interrogatives, and negation
- Vocabulary related to family, food, days of the week, weather, and basic verbs
