

# **French A2 Level Syllabus**

The A2 level builds upon the foundational knowledge of A1, helping learners handle simple communication in everyday situations. Students will become more confident in expressing themselves in basic social contexts.

## **1. Listening Comprehension**

- Understand frequently used expressions related to personal and family information, shopping, and local geography
- Follow short, clear announcements and instructions
- Identify the main point in short, clear messages and conversations

## **2. Reading Comprehension**

- Read short, simple texts on familiar topics
- Understand personal letters and everyday signs or instructions
- Follow simple written directions and short narratives

## **3. Speaking**

- Communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring direct information exchange
- Describe in simple terms aspects of their background and environment
- Engage in brief social conversations using learned expressions

## **4. Writing**

- Write short, simple notes and messages related to immediate needs
- Compose simple personal letters and describe daily routines

## **5. Grammar & Vocabulary**

- Expansion on present tense verbs and introduction to passé composé
- Use of reflexive verbs and future proche
- Broader use of prepositions, adjectives, and adverbs
- Increased vocabulary related to shopping, food, health, and transportation
